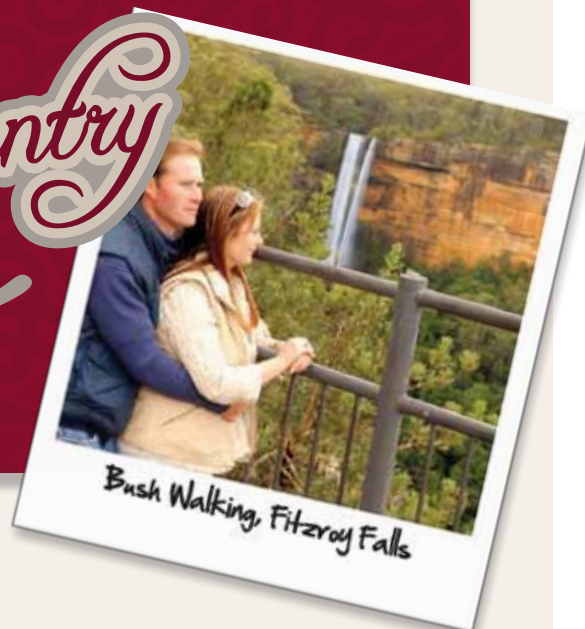

Sight Lyrebirds, parrots, ground thrush and kookaburras along the trails to these magnificent falls. The falls can be seen by following the boardwalk from the Visitors Centre or from walking tracks around the escarpment. Picnic areas with gas barbecues and huts are available.
